



Preheat oven to 220C / gas 7. Sift the flour, salt and mustard powder together into a large mixing bowl. Make a well in

should be the consistency of unwhipped double cream. Stir in the thyme.

Place the sausages into a 20 x 30cm roasting tin. Add 1 tbsp of the oil, tossing the sausages in it to thoroughly coat the base of the tin, then roast in the oven for 15 mins.

Remove the hot tray from the oven, then quickly pour in the batter – it will sizzle and bubble a little when it hits the hot fat. Return the tray to the oven. Bake for 40 mins until the batter is cooked, well risen and crispy.

#### For the Gravy

Cook the onions with the remaining oil gently in a non-stick pan until they are golden brown. Caramelise them by adding the sugar for the final 5 minutes. Add the spoonful of flour, then cook, stirring continuously, for 2 mins.

Gradually pour in the stock, stirring well to make a smooth sauce. Simmer for 4-5 mins to thicken, then season to taste. Cut the toad in the hole into large wedges and serve with the gravy spooned over

If you simply must hand over a bunch of cut flowers, try to choose blooms grown in the mild climate of the Scilly Isles as environmentally-friendly alternatives to exotic species flown in from the other side of the globe. 'Paperwhite' narcissi are beautifully scented and available now.



# BOOK REVIEW



In The Ice Twins, Tremayne successfully plays on the greatest fear of every parent: losing their child.

This is exactly what happened to Angus and Sarah Moorcroft. They lived the perfect life in London with their twin daughters, Kirstie and Lydia but a holiday to Sarah's parents' in Devon turned into tragedy when Lydia fell from a balcony and died.

#### Or did she?

Two girls, physically identical in every way but with very different personalities. Surely if anyone is able to tell them apart it would be their parents? Lydia, Sarah's thoughtful and quiet daughter is dead and she must rebuild her life and keep going for the sake of Kirstie.

A year after the accident, the family inherit a remote Scottish island and make arrangements to leave London where painful memories of Lydia are around every corner. Then Kirstie turns everything upside down with a simple question.

"Why do you keep calling me Kirstie, Mummy? Kirstie is dead. It was Kirstie that died. I'm Lydia."

Could Angus and Sarah really have got it wrong? Or is Kirstie just grieving for her dead twin sister? Is there something special that unites identical twins, even beyond the grave, and causes confusion and guilt at being the one to survive?

As the action moves to Scotland the fresh start that they hoped for comes crashing down around them. Just who did die on that day in Devon? And what exactly happened to cause a little girl to fall and lose her life? As the truth is slowly revealed, Sarah struggles to come to terms with the reality as she is slowly pulled into a pit of despair and anguish. The novel starts slowly but builds to a chilling climax that will haunt the reader long after the final paragraph has been digested. There are certain characters and stories that we have all grown up with. We know that it isn't a good idea to build a house out of straw or sticks. Apples given to us by strange old women might not be good for us. And planting some magic beans in your back garden is certainly not the smartest thing you could do unless you want to be attacked by giants! But they are just old stories, right?

#### Well, what if they weren't?

In this first novel in the Sisters Grimm series (aimed at children around the age of 10), we meet Sabrina and Daphne Grimm. They live in New York and have in the past year been placed with one foster family after another following the mysterious disappearance of their parents. The girls have become experts at running away from each home as they find themselves treated badly.

Suddenly, out of the blue, their grandmother appears and offers them a home: shocking as the girls had been told that she had died. The authorities don't seem too concerned by this - they are simply happy to get rid of Sabrina and Daphne – and so they are delivered a small town called Ferryport Landings and to the welcoming arms of Granny Relda.

But Ferryport Landings is no ordinary town, as the girls will soon discover. After all, how many schools have Snow White as a teacher? Here live the Everafters: characters from fairy-tales who are doomed to remain there for ever due to a curse. A curse that Sabrina and Daphne find themselves at the heart of.

It soon becomes clear that Granny Relda is no ordinary Granny and the fact that she is still alive is just one secret that has been kept from the Sisters Grimm.



#### Prestwich Heys FC

## Heys have hit the road in order to beat the weather.

After a near record making eight successive postponements, Heys took the decision to switch matches to 4G surfaces at Eccles College and the AJ Bell Stadium in order to get games played.

Jon Lyons's team opened the year on January 9th with a game against Boothstown, the team they had faced in their previous fixture back on November 7th.

Heys won that game 4-0 and opened 2016 at Eccles College, by going one better, recording a 5-0 success thanks to two goals from Max White and further strikes from Dalton McLaughlin, Greg Wills and Lee Bruce.

The AJ Bell Stadium was the next port of call and on a cold snowy day, Heys suffered their first league defeat of the season.

First half goals from Paul Tierney and Jamie Baguley appeared to have put Heys on the way to another win but AFC Monton roared back to win 3-2, the decisive strike coming with the very last kick of the game.

Despite the loss Heys remain top of the table on goal difference from Royton Town but have three games in hand on the Oldham side and many of the chasing pack.

It was back to Eccles for the Gilgryst Cup quarter final with Old Alts seven days later. With semi-final appearances in the Bolton Hospital Cup and Atherton Charity Cup already booked, Heys added a third to their diary with a 4-0 win courtesy of goals from Wills, Baguley, Wes Bancroft and Erike Sousa.

Heys Reserves have been able to fit in a couple of games too. A 1-1 draw with second placed Royton Town enabled them to cement their position at the top of the table. They now lead the Oldham side by four points but have six games in hand.

Matt Jolly's side also have a semi-final to look forward to in the Spring after a 3-0 quarter final

win at Wythenshawe Amateurs in the Open Trophy.

Whilst the pitch has been unplayable and games sparse Heys have been busy off the field. Their application to join the North West Counties League has been accepted by the FA and Heys will now go through the ground grading process to determine if they can return to the semi-professional ranks they last graced in 1986.

Planning permission for floodlights at Adie Moran Park has also been extended and the club are in talks now to get them installed in the next few months.

## **2015 INFINITY Q30**

This is my first drive on an Infiniti brand car. This isn't because I have something against them, but because they've never really been available in the UK before.

If you have never heard of Infiniti then let me fill you in quickly. Remember back in the early 90's when Lexus showed up on the scene and gave Mercedes & BMW a good run for their money with their new-money luxury cars? Well as I'm sure you already know they were just posh Toyotas.

Toyota decided that they were bored making every day cars and wanted a share of the premium car market, and so they came up with Lexus.

Well Infiniti is pretty much the same idea, but this time it's Nissan trying it.

During the early 90's when Toyota decided to take on ze Germans with Lexus they saw rather a lot of success, this was mostly because people were bored with what Mercedes and BMW had on offer and wanted something new & modern. I'm not for a second saying that the early Lexus models weren't good enough to take on the Germans head to head, they were great, and I know many people that chose to buy a Lexus LS400 rather than a 7 series or an S class.

The problem that Nissan have with their Infiniti range is that people aren't bored with Mercedes or BMW right now, and Audi are on fire and very trendy at the moment too, so do people really want a new marque or do they want the snobbery that comes with a German badge?

Because of this I'm not going to compare the Infiniti Q30 with a German marque, instead I am going to run it agains't it's main rival the Lexus NX. But also because I think it looks very similar and is priced very similar I'm comparing it to the Mazda CX-5 too.

I have the cheapest of the range on test, priced at £20,550. For this you get rather nice alloy wheels, single zone manual a/c, a single shot CD player and what I think is great standard kit – front collision alarm and auto stop. Apart from quite of a lot of airbags that's it for standard kit at this money.

The Lexus NX basic model starts at £29,995 but that is with a hybrid engine so there are some tax breaks in the UK with that. The Mazda CX-5 starts at £23,195, for this you get the same sort of kit, but with dual zone climate.

So the Infiniti wins on price, but it doesn't end there, it really does look pretty good, it's available in some slightly iffy colours and the grille for me looks a bit too like the Lexus but otherwise there are no complaints.

Where the style really starts to shine though is inside the cabin. It just feels very modern compared to the Mazda. You can spec many different finishes and colours on your interior trim so you can make it just how you would like



it, but be careful, personalise it too much and you'll never sell the thing on when you're done with it!

As I had the basic model, under the bonnet was a 1.6 turbo petrol engine with only front wheel drive. If you want a bit more engine and all wheel drive you will be looking at another £11,00 which I think is a bit steep personally.

To go bigger and all wheel drive in the Mazda costs from around £3,000 to £5,000. So while you may think the basic car is very reasonably priced, as I did, when you start playing with the options it can start to get a bit silly.

I can't really talk to much on what the driving experience was like because it doesn't really do anything that bad or that brilliantly, it's a nice drive and you would be pleased with it everyday, but nothing really stands out.

The seats are mightily comfy and all the buttons are where you would expect them to be, it does feel very well bolted together, you can tell that Nissan do care about the production of these and nothing at all about it felt in anyway Nissan'y, it does have the feel of a quality product.

My problem here is that all the time I've had the car I've been comparing it to the Mazda CX-5 because that's what I feel it most closely matches. Not that there is anything wrong with the Mazda but you wouldn't call them a premium brand would you? Where that is what Infiniti are trying to be.

For me I would rather they badged it as a Nissan and built it this well, it would do wonders for that brand which to be fair, doesn't anything that exciting going on in the UK right now apart from the GT-R.

If I was buying a cross-over or a small suv I'd still buy the Dacia Duster, for the basic price of this you can get a fully specced up Duster and still have enough change for a holiday.

If you want a posh badge that will impress the neighbours, then get a German. Which is exactly what you have been doing and will continue to do, isn't it? Great prices for Prestwich and Whitefield people!
