### TOKOLOSH -STAY STRONG (Jack to Phono)

STAY STRONG was released at the start of August with about as much fuss as the average Englishman feels comfortable making in a restaurant. The latest project by Prestwich singer/songwriter Liam Frost (along with members of The Earlies and The Whip) feels designed to actively avoid the spotlight.

This apparent commitment to ninja-like stealth seems completely in keeping with the identity of the band. They rarely play live and eschew aggressive self-promotion in favour of an online presence so oblique and humourous it's enough to make you think that Andy Kaufman might still be alive. This might be understandable if STAY STRONG (their caps) was some throwaway musical joke or a willful art project but in actual fact it's a remarkable collection of dark, highly evolved pop songs. Which makes it all the sadder that it has "great lost album" written all over it.

Frost's voice navigates a sea of itchy percussion

and bubbling, glassy keyboards. Bass lines punch and snake through the surface, punctuated by stabs and jolts of tense, economical guitar. These are taut, muscular songs, given a heart by vocals that swerve from blue-eyed soul to a soaring falsetto so potent it could knock a kestrel out of the sky. This music is sophisticated but never elitist. Sometimes remote and mathematical but never clinical or soulless. It grabs fistfuls of disparate genres and mashes them together, creating a musical identity that persists across the album; a defined sound aping everyone and no one. There are burps of disco and New Romanticism. Walls of digital fuzz and waves of swooning keys. But most importantly, there are songs.

"Shapeshifter" slinks and struts insistently into your brain. "The Hollow" clatters into a dark tunnel and insists that you follow it. "Bloodlines" pulses intriguingly then flies off with your breath. "Tokohorse" is the song Jeff Buckey's "Everybody Here Wants You" should have been. And "Quivering Pines", perhaps the album's finest moment, glitters like moonlit sands at evening tide. These are songs that handcuff themselves to you and swallow the key.

In short, STAY STRONG is too good to disappear unnoticed. Certainly too good to end up as a rarity in the hands of chin-stroking record collectors. They won't feel it. They won't dance to it. But you, you deserve it. And it deserves you. So do the right thing; save a great lost album.





For some people, Just wanting a motorcycle is reason enough for buying one. However, there are benefits to owning a motorcycle other than just fulfilling a desire. Motorcycle riders take to 2 wheels for a huge range of reasons.

#### Affordability

Whether you are buying new or used, a decent motorcycle costs much less than a car with equivalent performance. Many motorcyclists only ride for pleasure in good weather and as a consequence there are many low mileage machines available secondhand at bargain prices.

Fuel economy is often a major consideration in vehicle choice. Many mid-sized motorcycles will

mid-sized motorcycles will return 60-70mpg whilst still being capable of motorway speeds with ease. We are now seeing 125cc machines, with fuel injection, exceeding 120 mpg even riding around town.

Motorcycle insurance is considerably lower that car insurance. Most insurers offer no claims bonuses and discounts for riders who undertake refresher training. Many young riders are finding that their premiums are a tenth of car premiums.

Finding a place to park is much easier on a motorcycle. In reality it is almost always possible to park for free. Many Greater Manchester authorities allow free parking on meters and in the dedicated motorcycle areas in their car parks. Even when this is not the case there are always plenty of spaces to squeeze a 2 wheeler into.

#### The Environment

Motorcycles are very environmentally friendly. They tend to have lower emissions than larger vehicles, cause less damage to the road surface and reduce congestion by taking up much less space on the roads. As a result, road tax starts from as little as  $\pounds$  16 per year.

#### **Pleasure Riding**

Some motorcyclists use their machines purely for pleasure. This could be evening rides in the Summer, weekends away or European touring. Others are solely commuters over both long and short distances. Many riders combine both and also own a car for family trips. The choice is entirely individual but once made you will be part of a growing band that now numbers over 1 million in the UK alone.



#### **Training and Safety**

All learner riders will need to undertake a course of basic training as a minimum. Riders wishing to ride machines over 125cc will need to pass their motorcycle test. Riders will be given advice on clothing, machine choice and how to stay safe on the road. A variety of training options are available with dedicated and enthusiastic instructors. Visit www.ltirider.com for legal and training advice.



# **Book Review**

### The Night Circus Erin Morgenstern

"The circus arrives without warning ... It is simply there when yesterday it was not"

So begins this adult fantasy novel. From the seductive opening you are drawn into the world of the circus. The mysterious circus owner, Prospero the Enchanter, otherwise known as Hector Bowen, is a magician



and Le Cirque des Rêves is the greatest accomplishment of his career. Magic unfolds on every page as his circus and its assembled performers enchant and amaze its audience. Time moves differently in the circus, as the performers appear not to age. Acrobats perform without safety nets and the audience move from one spectacle to another, created by the illusionist who transforms tents on a whim.

Fates intertwine as two young protégés must meet and compete on this unsuspecting stage. The ultimate bet will be decided after years of dedication and preparation.

Set in America and Europe in the late 1800s this novel oozes with an era that never quite existed. A steampunk retelling of the Victorian age that you will wish you could visit. The language is poetic and evocative and you will find yourself longing for the day when the circus arrives near you without warning. You too will want to wear a red scarf and join the rêveurs.

#### Magic Tree House: Valley of the Dinosaur Mary Pope Osbourne

Time travel. A quest to solve. Exciting adventures. This book for young readers who are growing in confidence has all of these and much more. The first of a series of books, it follows the adventures of Jack and Annie as they discover a magic treehouse in their neighbourhood.

As the story begins Jack and Annie are chasing an imaginary monster into a nearby wood when they stumble across a solitary treehouse. Curiosity getting the better of them, they decide to

explore and inside they find wonderful collection of books. Jack is drawn to a dinosaur book and before they know it the two children are transported back to the time of the dinosaurs.

Full of fascinating facts this book will appeal to anv budding palaeontologist. At ten chapters this is a nice introduction to reading without seeming too daunting. The sentence structure can be repetitive and simplistic, but I am assured bv vouna



readers that this is not a problem!

There are currently sixteen books available in the series covering different time periods and geographic locations. These along, with an interactive website, promise to engage and educate young readers for many a long school holiday.

### Hungarian Beef Goulash

As Autumn draws in I like to make one pot dishes and this next recipe is a staple dish in my household. Its tasty and mild enough for all the family and a great alternative to to stew or hotpot.

Don't get too hung up on needing all the spices. The paprika is essential but if you dont have bay leaf or caraway seeds, don't worry.



It can be served with fluffy white rice, mashed potatoes or even roasts and of course any veg of your choosing or add extra potatoes into the dish and serve with a chunk of tasty fresh baked bread & butter.

### Ingredients

1kg of Topside Beef or good quality braising steak

Salt and freshly ground black pepper

1 large onion chopped

2-3 cloves of garlic

2 bay leaves

50 oz paprika

2 tsp of caraway seeds

1.5 litres of beef stock

1 carton of passata (sieved tomatoes)

3-4 carrots chopped into chunks

2-3 large potatoes peeled and cut into chunks

Sour cream or low fat yohgurt to garnish and flat leaf chopped parsley (optional)

### Method

Preheat oven at 200°C in a large casserole dish/pan. Gently brown the onions, meat and seasoning, add the paprika and garlic and fry for a few more minutes.

Then add the stock, bay leaf and the passata.

Reduce the oven to 180°C and bring everything to a boil on the hob.

Transfer to an oven proof dish, cover and cook for 1.5 hours before adding the potatoes, carrots and bay leaf.

Cook for a further 30 mins until tender serve and enjoy!

# **PW** Gardening

### **Blooms From Bulbs**

It may seem early to begin planning next year's spring and summer colour, but it is essential to get bulbs planted this month (with the exception of Tulips which should be planted in November).

The history of bulbs can almost be traced back to the beginning of man, when they would most certainly have been used as food. We know that the ancient Egyptians grew onions and that potatoes (technically tubers) have been cultivated in South America for thousands of years. I wonder what these early people would think to the use of our ornamental onions, such as Allium 'Pinball Wizard', grown for their show stopping flowers!

Most of the usual subjects including Allium bulbs can be planted right now, and range in price from the very cheap tiny bulbs of Allium sphaerocephalon, to the more rare and expensive giant heads of Allium schubertii. Most kinds of Alliums enjoy a position in full sun, but if you have a very dry and shaded border such as that under a large tree, then try Allium ursinum, more commonly known as wild garlic. Its beautiful lush, low growing green foliage makes a great foil for a woodland setting, as well as producing a mass of white globular flowers borne on short stems.

When buying and planting bulbs, try and follow these general rules:

·Wear gloves when handling, as some are toxic and can cause

#### skin irritations

 Try and buy them loose so you can feel them. Give each a gentle squeeze and check they are firm. Reject any which are not, or appear to have shrivelled, and those showing any sign of mould (normally grey/blue in colour).

 Reject any showing excess signs of growth, with either long or pale stems. Bulbs should not be showing any sign of growth, but a short tip is ok

· Damaged or split bulbs should not be selected

 Plant using a bulb planter, allowing a hole twice the diameter of the bulb and about 3 times the depth, but I would advise to research it as each variety is different.

· Place a little bone meal in the hole for good root development

Bulbs can also be grown from seed. They take a good few years to flower, around five in my experience, but it's very satisfying when they finally do and you can even have a go at cross pollinating to make your own varieties.

Other favourites of mine are:

- · Tulip 'Prinses Irene' an exquisite orange and purple flower.
- Narcissus 'Thalia' a white and scented daffodil.

Galtonia, an imposing 60cm tall with grass like foliage and a 90cm high flower spike in white.

Chionodoxa, with around 10 blue blooms per stalk, this is a small but cheery bulb.

### **Back To School Bugs**

How does it happen? Your family has enjoyed a happy, healthy six week summer holiday, but within just days of returning to school your child comes down with a cold, or develops an itchy skin condition, or catches nits. Why, when they need to be settling into a new routine and you need to be back at work, do they suddenly get ill?

Like it or not, children gathering in schools is one of the main ways germs circulate in communities. Their immune systems are less mature, they tend to be in close contact, and they have 'germy' habits like sticking fingers or pencils into their mouths, so it is inevitable that they are going to come home with something nasty at some point.

That said, most illnesses can be avoided if a few good practices are followed. Top of the list is to make sure that your child's immunisations are all up to date, and that all family members have had a seasonal flu vaccination, where appropriate. Prevention is definitely the best medicine.

Next, make sure they wash their hands enough and properly! The most common way to catch illness is through the mouth, eyes or nose after the hands have been in contact with infected surfaces. A thorough wash with soap and warm water to the back of the hands, in between the fingers and around the nails for 20 seconds (as long as it takes to sing 'Happy Birthday' twice!) before eating or drinking, after a visit to the toilet, blowing their nose, or touching animals and waste, should be the minimum.

Teach your child 'germ etiquette'. This means staying away from other children who may be sneezing or coughing, covering their own coughs and sneezes by using tissues that should be thrown away immediately, and avoiding head to head contact with others. If your child is older, warn them about sharing items such as lipstick, lip balm, make-up, razors, creams, lotions and other personal items such as towels and sports kit.



There are some germ hotspots in schools, and cafeteria trays are one of them! One survey found that there were more bacteria per square inch on a cafeteria tray than there were on a toilet seat, probably because the trays don't get cleaned as often. If your child drops food on a tray, they should throw it away!

Finally, your child can build up their immunity by getting enough sleep and exercise, eating a well balanced diet that includes lots of fresh fruit and vegetables, and by drinking plenty of water. Take these preventative measures and hopefully going back to school will be a happy, healthy time for everybody!
